



Green or Non-Sanctioned Class Rules/Requirements

Green Horse	None	No	No	Must use 1 or 1 hands consistently throughout the pattern May use any legal bit including snaffle or bosal	Must execute a flying lead change
Ladies/Men	None	No	No	This class uses regular NRHA patterns and all NRHA rules apply.	

All classes use standard NRHA patterns and rules except as noted above.

+These classes run concurrently.

* The phrase “at any time” is taken directly from the NRHA handbook. It has been interpreted to show management to mean the rider may switch from 1 to 2 hands or from 2 hands to 1 at any time in the pattern.

** The lead change may be accomplished in any of the ways listed without penalty.

Membership in TNRHA is not required to participate in any of the shows. TNRHA membership is required for TNRHA Green Reiner class participation. To be eligible for year-end awards in any class, both the rider and at least 1 owner must be members of TNRHA.

Eligibility:

NRHA Green Rider: NRHA Green Level I - Open to riders who have less than \$200 in NRHA earnings, have less than 75 NRHA Youth points and less than 200 Classic Equine Green Reiner points. **NRHA Green Level II** - Open to riders who have less than \$350 in NRHA earnings, have less than 175 NRHA Youth points and less than 350 Classic Equine Green Reiner points

TNRHA Green Reiner: Open to any rider who qualifies for NRHA Green 1 or 2 and HAS NOT earned more than 120 TNRHA Green Reiner Program points OR more than \$350 in NRHA earnings (Category 10 earnings do not apply) and is a member of TNRHA. Eligibility for the year is based on points or winnings as of 12/31 of the previous year; once eligible, riders may show in Green classes for the entire show year.

TNRHA Green Youth: Rider may not have more than 10 NRHA youth points.

Green Horse: Eligibility is based on the horse—may not have any NRHA earnings prior to Jan. 1.

Ladies/Men: open to any rider; there are no modifications to rules or patterns.
